## WHAT IS MY RING SIZE?

If you don't know your ring size, you can follow these steps:

1. Measure the base of your finger with a tape measure.

Our tip: Measure your knuckle as well. Remember to choose a size that you can put on and take off the ring comfortably.
2. If you don't have a tape measure handy, you can also take a tape or string to measure the base of your finger. Make a small mark with the measurement where the circle closes and measure it with a ruler.
3. Use our "size guide" chart to choose your size. Choose the closest size possible. Our tip: If you hesitate between two sizes, always go for the larger size. If you need a size that does not appear in the table, do not hesitate to contact us.

## DO YOU WANT TO GIVE A RING AS A GIFT?

If you don't know your ring size, you can follow these steps:

1. Borrow a ring from the person to whom you want to give the gift.
2. Print this document.

Before printing, make sure that the printing scale is correct. To do this you must set the page scaling to "none". You will find this option in the print dialog box (by pressing CRT+P, or by opening the menu bar: file > print > scaling).

To make sure that the scaling is correct, measure the bottom bar. It should measure exactly 5 cm .

3. Place the ring on top of the circles to find the size. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circles and choose the best fit.
A tip: if the ring is between two sizes, go for the larger one.
